Dear Parents,

On Friday 6th June 2025, Year 5 will be visiting the Somerset Rural Life Museum in Glastonbury. We will be learning about:

- To understand the importance of honeybees within environments and our food cycle
- To explore the honeybee contextually through activities
- To develop speaking and listening skills and working cooperatively
- To create print work inspired by a global bee project
- We will be travelling by coach, leaving school at 09:15 and will be back in time for the end of the day at 15:15.

Children must wear school uniform to ensure that they are easily identifiable at the museum. They will also need a packed lunch and water bottle on that day to take with them on the trip. If you have already booked a school lunch on Arbor, you will be able to cancel the meal until **Friday 16th May 2025**.

Alternatively, lunches booked can be credited back to your account for future bookings. If your child is normally entitled to free school meals, then a packed lunch will be provided.

We ask that parents pay a voluntary contribution of £8.90 per child. If we do not receive enough contributions, the trip will not be able to go ahead. **Consent can be given, and payment can be made on Arbor under the Trips menu.**
