Dear Parents,

Our Sports day is fast approaching and with that in mind, this year's Sports Day has been remodelled and revamped with a **new and exciting format** for the children to take part in. Both Mr Dunningham and I are excited to invite you to join us to watch and support the children take part as they amass points for their sports teams.

We wanted to send out some key information regarding next half term's Sports Day prior to half term so that we can invite as many of you into the school to watch and cheer on the children as possible.

This year parents are invited to watch the track events in the afternoon (from 13:05), after the children have taken part in their carousel of field events in the morning.

Thursday 19th June (all timings are subject to change)

- Years 1,2,3 will take part in a carousel of sporting field events in the first half of the morning from 09:00 – 10:30.
- Years 4,5,6 will then take part in their carousel of sporting field events in the second half of the morning from 10:30 – 12:00.
- Lunch for all children will be from 12:00 – 13:00.
- Parents are then invited onto the school site to make their way to the track, which is located on the school field, from 13:05 onwards. Entrance to the school is via the main gate closest to the office.
- At 13:20 a 'Welcome Presentation' from Mr Seviour as the children make their way onto the track.
- In the afternoon Reception, year 1 and 2 will take part in their track events on one half of the track from 13:25 – 14:50.

- Year 3 - 6 will take part in their track events on the other side of the track again from 13:25 – 14:50.
- End of day presentation to take place at 14:55.
- All children return to the classroom for collection from 15:15.

Friday 20th June – Whole School

There will be a whole school Sports Day celebration assembly to celebrate the children's achievements and success. Mr Dunningham and I will finally reveal which sports team has amassed the most points to lift the coveted Blackbrook Sports Day Trophy!

A class communication will be sent nearer the time via each class to remind your child which colour sports team they are in. If possible, could your child please wear a t-shirt of their house group colour (if not normal PE kit is fine!).

Lunches - both hot dinners and packed lunches will be as normal. If you do have any further questions, please do not hesitate to ask either myself or Mr Dunningham.
