Dear Parents,

Our **new and exciting format** for Sports Day has nearly arrived: **Thursday 19th June**

Both Mr Dunningham and myself just wanted to again communicate with you all that we are really excited to have parents onsite again to watch, cheer and support the children. **This year parents are invited to watch the track events in the afternoon, after the children have taken part in their carousel of field events in the morning.**

Your child's class teacher will be communicating house teams shortly with you or your child as to which house team they are representing and we ask that they could if possible, please wear a t-shirt of their house group colour (if not normal PE kit is fine!).

The afternoon will consist of the children's track events and we ask that parents sit around the outside perimeter of the track. The children will sit inside the track. We ask you to sign in and enter the school via the main gate closest to the office, these gates will be open from roughly 13:05.

Thursday 19th June (all timings are subject to change)

- **Years 1, 2 & 3** will take part in a carousel of sporting field events in the first half of the morning from 09:00 – 10:30.
- **Years 4, 5 & 6** will then take part in their carousel of sporting field events in the second half of the morning from 10:30 – 12:00.
- Lunch for all children will be from 12:00 – 13:00.
- Parents are then invited onto the school site to make their way to the track, which is located on the school field, from 13:05 onwards. Entrance to the school is via the main gate closest to the office.
- At 13:20 a 'Welcome Presentation' from Mr Seviour as the children make their way onto the track.

- In the afternoon, **Reception, Year 1 and 2** will take part in their track events on one half of the track from 13:25 – 14:50.
- **Years 3 - 6** will take part in their track events on the other side of the track again from 13:25 – 14:50.
- End of day presentation to take place at 14:55.
- All children return to the classroom for collection from 15:15.

On Friday there will be a whole school Sports Day celebration assembly to celebrate the children's achievements and success. Mr Dunningham and I will finally reveal which house team has amassed the most points to lift the coveted Blackbrook Sports Day Trophy!

Finally, we look forward to watching the children take part and welcoming you all to cheer on all of the children!
