Year 2 trip to Haynes Motor Museum

Dear Parents,

To support and enhance the children's learning of '**Changes within living memory**,' we have organised an exciting school trip to Haynes Motor Museum on Friday 11th July. This is a fantastic learning opportunity for the children which aims to help increase their **understanding of our past** by focusing on how the lives of great grandparents, grandparents and parents have changed over the years. The children will have the opportunity to take part in a workshop with staff at Haynes, take a tour around the museum and experience sitting in some classic cars.

The workshop will also be based around **producing a motor vehicle** which is our school DT topic this year. This will be a whole day of learning; we aim to leave promptly after the morning register and aim to be back by 3:15 at the very latest.

For our trip to go ahead, we are asking parents/carers for a voluntary contribution of **£14.00 per child**. This includes a return coach journey, entry into Haynes Motor Museum and a bespoke workshop led by one of the site leaders. Although this is a voluntary donation, if we do not receive enough to cover costs, the trip may not be able to proceed. Payment can be made via Arbour.

As we will be at Haynes all day, your child will need to be provided with a snack, packed lunch and a drink. Children should wear school uniform for the trip.
