Year 4 Swimming Lessons

Dear Parents,

During the Spring term, we will be offering Year 4 swimming lessons. This is so the children can aim to meet the National Curriculum standards.

The swimming lessons will take place at 2pm each Monday at Blackbrook Pavilion **starting on Monday 12th January until Monday 30th March.**

The children will need the following items:

- Swimming costume or trunks (no bikinis or board shorts)
- Towel (girls may bring an extra towel for their hair – a small towel or a turban towel is best)
- Separate swimming bag which they can carry and is large enough to contain all their swimming kit
- Swimming hat is optional but long hair must be tied back.
- Goggles (optional but will not be provided)

All children will be expected to participate as it is a requirement of the curriculum, regardless of their swimming ability. Please ensure that you log in to Arbor to give your consent for us to take your child off-site for these lessons.

I am also very pleased to share that there will be no charge to parents. Schools generally ask for contributions to cover the costs; however, we have taken the decision to absorb this cost within our core budget.

The instructors have requested the following information to assist with their assessment procedures for the lessons: name, date of birth, and medical conditions. This information will be stored confidentially by the instructors.
