### **Class 1 – Marvellous Materials Workshop – Tuesday 3<sup>rd</sup> March**

Dear Parents,

On Tuesday 3<sup>rd</sup> March, Class 1 will be visiting the Somerset Rural Life Museum in Glastonbury. We will be learning about:

- Working scientifically: asking simple questions, observe closely, identifying and classifying and performing simple tests.
- Be able to distinguish between an object and the material from which it is made.
- To develop the speaking and listening skills of asking questions and suggesting answers to questions.
- To identify and name a variety of everyday materials and describe simple physical properties of them

We will be travelling by coach, leaving school at 09:15 and will be back in time for the end of the day at 15:15.

Children must wear school uniform to ensure that they are easily identifiable at the museum. They will also need a packed lunch and water bottle on that day to take with them on the trip. If your child is normally entitled to free school meals, then a packed lunch will be provided.

We ask that parents pay a voluntary contribution of £9.67 per child. If we do not receive enough contributions, the trip will not be able to go ahead. Payment can be made on Arbor via the Trips menu.
