They will be using 2Paint-a-Picture; sharing work to a Display Board; using 2Respond (2Email) to start to communicate by email on Purple Mash and they will be learning about what a digital footprint is and how to think about the information that they leave online. Effective Searching: These lessons allow the children to develop an understanding of what the Internet is. It will also give them the basic tools to help them search for information more effectively.
