This is a lovely opportunity for children to reflect on their lives now and think creatively about the future.

What does my child need to do?

Children are invited to create a **piece of work at home**, which could include:

- Writing
- Drawing
- A combination of both

Teachers will have shared ideas and prompts in class to support this.

Ideas to help at home

Here are some simple ideas you may wish to explore with your child:

Life Today (2026)

- Draw or write about school now
- What do they learn?
- What do they use (books, iPads, playgrounds)?

Life in the Future (2076)

- What might school look like in 50 years?
- Could there be robot teachers or flying classrooms?
- What might a school day be like?

Looking Back at Us

- What might children in the future think about us?
- What might seem old-fashioned?

What Should Never Change

- What does your child love about school?
- What do they hope stays the same? (e.g. friends, playtime, kindness)

Creative Ideas

Children could include:

- A drawing or picture
- A short piece of writing
- A labelled diagram
- A mix of writing and artwork

Please return all completed entries by Friday 3rd July.

Selection for the Time Capsule

From each class, **two pieces of work will be selected** to be placed inside the time capsule.

The children chosen will also be **invited to attend a special event** to help bury the capsule in Sherwell manor gardens.
