School Arrangements for Friday

Dear Parents,

Following our previous communication regarding the extreme heat, we have been informed that the Red Heat Health Alert may have been extended to Friday and would like to confirm that **the same arrangements will remain in place for Friday 26 June**. We will continue to keep the safety and wellbeing of our children and staff as our highest priority. The measures outlined in our earlier letter will remain in place throughout the day, including regular access to drinking water, the use of shaded and well-ventilated spaces, and adaptations to reduce physical activity during the hottest periods of the day.

As with the rest of this week, we will continue to offer an **optional early collection time from 1:30pm onwards**. Children may be collected from the school office from this time if families feel this is the best option for them. Alternatively, children may remain in school until the normal end of the school day at 3:15pm.

We recognise that many parents have chosen to keep their children at home during this period of exceptionally hot weather. We completely understand and respect these decisions. **Any absence related to the current extreme weather conditions and family choice during this period will not have a negative impact on your child's attendance record**. We simply ask that you continue to inform the school if your child will not be attending.

Thank you once again for your continued support, understanding and cooperation during this unusual spell of weather. We have greatly appreciated the way our school community has worked together to ensure that children remain safe, comfortable and well cared for.

We hope that you and your families stay safe and keep cool over the coming days.
