The children have worked incredibly hard throughout the year and have grown so much in confidence, independence and their love of learning. We would like to treat them to a fun-filled day at the beach as a way of celebrating all that they have achieved together.

We will be travelling by coach, leaving school promptly at 9:00 a.m. During the day, the children will take part in a range of exciting beach-based activities, including:

- Creating artwork using sand and pebbles.
- Fun beach games, including parachute activities.

- Send your child with a small backpack containing:
 - a packed lunch,
 - a water bottle,
 - a named bottle of sun cream for reapplication throughout the day,
 - a named sun hat,
 - a small bucket and spade (if you have one!)

Please ensure that all items are clearly named.

To help cover the cost of the coach travel and your child's ice cream, we kindly ask for a contribution of £12.00 per child. We would be very grateful if payment could be made by **Tuesday 7th July** via Arbor. Your contribution will help us make this special celebration possible for all of the children. Please note that we may need to cancel the event if enough contributions are not provided.

The children will be supervised by school staff throughout the day, and all activities have been carefully planned to ensure everyone has a safe, enjoyable and memorable experience.

We will begin our journey home by boarding the coach at approximately 1:45 p.m., aiming to return to school in time for our usual 3:15 p.m. collection. We kindly ask that all children are collected at the normal end-of-school time.

We are incredibly proud of everything the children have achieved this year and cannot think of a better way to celebrate the end of their Reception journey. We are looking forward to spending a wonderful day together and making some very special memories.
